CALL FOR PAPERS

Technical papers are solicited on all aspects of combustion including chemical kinetics; soot and PAH; heterogeneous combustion; alternative fuels and engine combustion; combustion diagnostics; supersonic combustion; and innovative and emerging concepts in combustion. Papers may cover a broad range of focus, from fundamental combustion phenomena to practical applications of combustion technology. Papers from industrial organizations are strongly encouraged. Please note that presentation of a paper at this meeting does not constitute archival publication.

DEADLINES

Prospective authors should submit an abstract of 100 to 200 words online at the Combustion Institute website at <http://www.combustioninstitute.org> under the Conferences tab by **July 29, 2015**. Decisions on acceptance will be transmitted to the authors by **August 12, 2015** by the WSS/CI Program Chair, David Lignell of Brigham Young University. Full papers of at least 5 pages in length are to be submitted electronically and will be distributed to all registrants. Presentation of papers is contingent upon having an electronic copy of the accepted paper received by **August 26, 2015**.

REGISTRATION FEE

Access to the conference proceedings is included in the cost of meeting registration. The fee for advance registration is \$240 (members of the Combustion Institute), \$280 (non-members), \$65 (student members with suitable identification), \$75 (student non-members). The advance registration deadline is **September 2, 2015** after which the fees are \$280/\$320/\$70/\$85. Forty dollars of the differential charged for non-members (\$10 for students) will be applied toward membership in the Combustion Institute. STUDENT TRAVEL AWARDS

The Western States Section of the Combustion Institute awards a travel stipend of up to \$150 to each non-local student (travel distance > 50 miles) presenting a paper. Student presenters must apply for awards no later than **September 21, 2015** to be considered for an award. Please send student applications to Prof. Guillaume Blanquart at g.blanquart@caltech.edu. The application should include the title of the presentation, the student's mailing address, and a statement from the faculty advisor verifying that the student is registered at his/her home institution. To receive the travel award, the faculty advisor (or senior lab scientist) must accompany the student presenter to the meeting.
